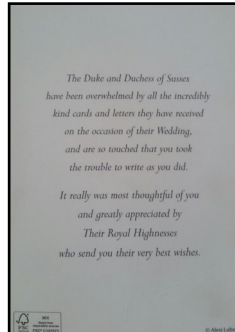


A Royal Response for Year 4
